The information sought by applicant on cultivated land in Sikkim State (latest available) is available in the Directorate's annual publication titled as "Land Use Statistics At A Glance 2006-07 to 2015-16". The publication is uploaded on the Directorate's website and may be accessed with the link https://eands.dacnet.nic.in/LUS_1999_2004.htm However, information sought on other aspects is not maintained with this division.
